Teachers and educational leaders in schools will partner with academics to explore theory, current research and the practical implications for pedagogy and whole school organisation as related to Multicultural Education. Presenters will also expand on current projects and ideas that have been successfully applied in school settings, both primary and secondary. They will explore the themes of cultural diversity in schools, anti – racism, social and cultural insights for teachers, EAL/D pedagogy and curriculum.

The conference will feature keynote addresses and presentations from Dr Christina Ho (UTS), Associate Professor Megan Watkins (WSU) and Professor Greg Noble (WSU).
