



Primary Conference Your First Years of Teaching Monday, 1st April 2019 Surry Hills

All presenters are experienced K-6 teachers. Mary-Ellen Betts, Jenny Williams and Sandra Rowan have worked in a number of schools in NSW as consultants, classroom teachers and in executive positions.

This whole day conference will focus on the particular needs of early career teachers in primary school settings. This conference will explore some of the interests and concerns that are unique to early career teachers. Through the varied options offered on the day teachers will gain an understanding of how to address the needs of their students in English and Mathematics.

The day will consist of a plenary talk: 'From inspiration to reality.' Armed with years of study, early career teachers approach the classroom. Reality can be very different to university study. Individual school practices can look very different. How do you find a path that works for you and your students?

In addition, participants will be able to select three elective sessions across the day.
